COVID Update

- On Thursday, May 13, The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) released guidance stating that people who have completed vaccination against COVID-19 can safely resume many activities that were done prior to the start of the pandemic. The CDC guidance specifically highlights: "Fully vaccinated people can resume activities without wearing a mask or physically distancing."
- Local and state guidelines must be followed.
- However, there are important exceptions to the CDC's guidance change on masking and distancing. The new guidelines are not intended for:
 - Health care settings, including hospitals and nursing homes. Employees, physicians, members, patients, and visitors must continue to adhere to current masking and distancing requirements.
- Children 11 and under are not yet able to be vaccinated.



COVID Reminders

- You still must use PPE even if vaccinated.
- Submit the direct exposure form Call Customer Service within 2 hours of known **direct exposure** and send in completed form within 24 hours.
- Don't forget about the "COVID-19 & the BHPN Informational Guide" for Caregivers.
- Encourage families and clients to follow CDC guidelines, including mask toleration.

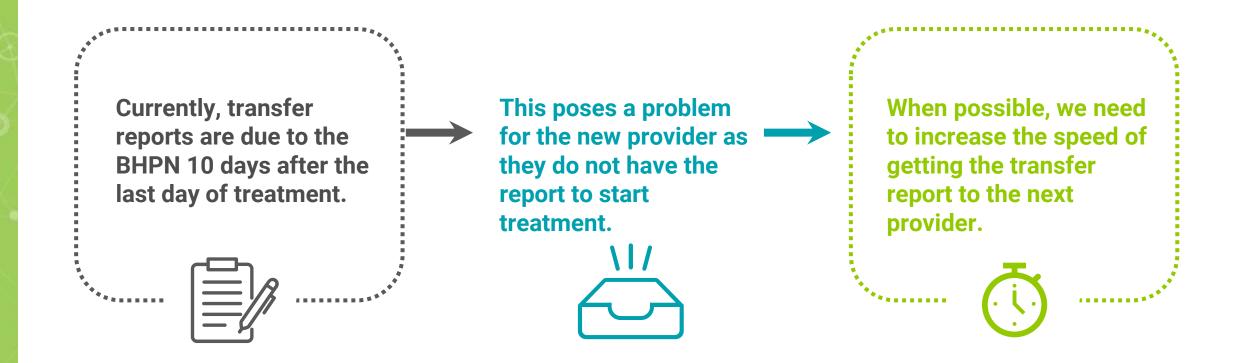
- Meeting will encompass both operational and clinical updates

Transfer Reports



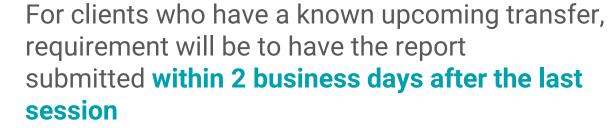
AS A REMINDER...

Diagnostic Evaluations, the BHT IA (if conducted in the last year) and any reports that were completed in the last 6 months are included at the time of transfer for the new provider.











Options for unexpected transfers:

- May take a little longer than 2 business days to submit a report
 - It should be no longer then 10 days
- For complicated cases, possible collaboration call with both providers and CCM

The last Excel "Daily Placement List" Sent After 6/4

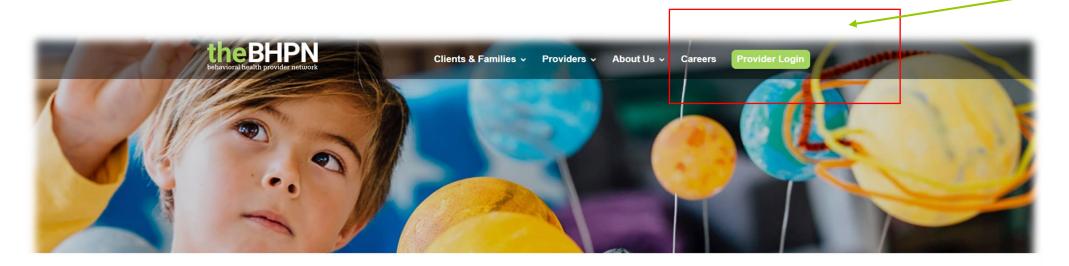


Work With Your Provider Portal Administrator to Get Appropriate Access

Access to The Provider Portal via Company Website



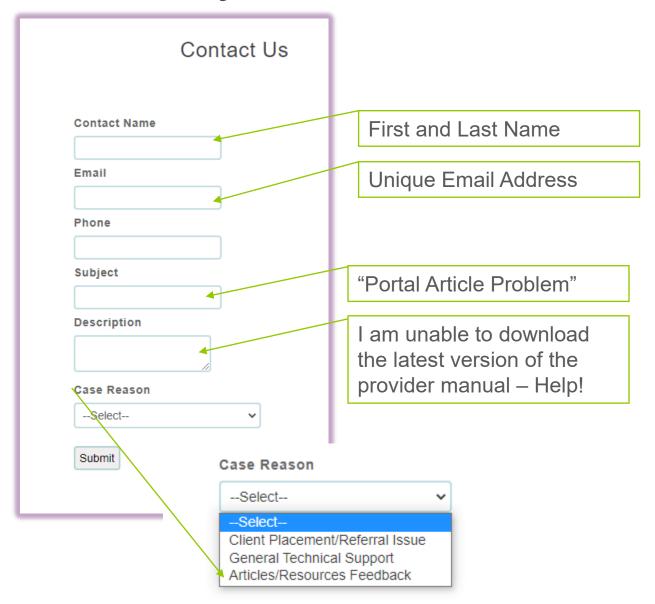
About the BHPN
