A naturalistic developmental intervention for young children





What is Chat?

- Chat is a naturalistic-developmental and language-based model of intervention. This routine-based, parent-mediated program is available for children 6 years of age and younger and their families.
- Chat is a fun, developmentally and routinebased approach to treatment for families looking for a more naturalistic model or an alternative to ABA.









Implemented as a one-tier or two-tier parent-mediated program



Increased COVID Exposure

Over the past two weeks, our providers have submitted a significant increase in COVID exposure reports.

Daily Trends in Number of Cases and Cumulative Incidence Rate of COVID-19 Cases in California Reported to CDC, per 100,000 population.




- Per CDC, "As of January 5, 2022, the current 7-day moving average of daily new cases (586,391) increased 85.7% compared with the previous 7-day moving average (315,851)."
- As a reminder, please submit the direct exposure form — Call Customer Service within 2 hours of known direct exposure and send in completed form within 24 hours.



COVID Reminders

- Encourage families and clients to **follow CDC guidelines**, including mask toleration.
- You still must use PPE even if vaccinated.
- If a practitioner is experiencing any symptoms, regardless of vaccination status, in-person treatment should not be performed by that practitioner.
- Remember that telehealth is a great option if there are any concerns regarding exposure.

Discharges

- Submit discharge reports after the final session date and within at least 10-days of the final session.
 - Clients who may need to continue with another vendor cannot move forward until KP receives the report.
- Due to authorization issues, for all reports indicating discharge, including clinical discharge, please send a notification email to theBHPN indicating the discharge and anticipated discharge date.
 - This will alleviate the need to submit the report when the progress note is due.
- If there are concerns with scheduling which is leading to an administrative discharge, first **notify BHPN** to determine if there is another provider who can support the family's scheduling needs before submitting report.

- Please ensure revisions are completed by the end of the next business day.
- Revision feedback is now sent via auto emails.
 - CC pertinent individuals when submitting reports so they will be included on any automated revision feedback emails.
- Please use the KP Instructional Guide Sheet when completing all reports.
- Be sure to use the diagnosis code found in the authorization.
- Speech Therapy and Occupational Therapy transfer reports are no longer needed, unless the progress note is due.



BHPN Guidelines

Parent Concerns Regarding Additional Service Lines

• Families should contact KP member services or speak to their pediatrician.

Collaboration vs. Co-treating

- Over lapped sessions or co-treating: simply bill as usual.
- Collaboration: should start with the BCBA assigned to the case, please reach out to theBHPN if you need contact information.

WSU (Weekly Status Update)

- Per contract with KP, an appointment within 10-days of placement/first date must be offered. BHPN must share this information with KP.
- If a family declines placement or there is no contact, an email must be sent to theBHPN.org vs. documenting on the WSU.



BHPN Guidelines Continued

 Re-Authorization treatment letters will only be sent if there is clinical information to disseminate.

BHPN Portal

- Check at least monthly for calendar events and BHPN updates.
